The Wonderland Auction is Cascadia Wildlands' largest fundraiser of the year, accounting for 1/5-1/4 of our total operating budget for the following year. It has been a challenging year for all of us dealing with COVID-19 and devastating wildfires, as well as political and social turmoil. December 5 is an evening for us to come together, to help protect — and celebrate — all that is wonderful and wild in our region.

Our Silent Auction will be open for bidding online for the week prior to our live streamed event on December 5, giving folks plenty of time to keep their eye on the items they are hankering for! Any items you donate will be prominently displayed on our website for that entire week, along with promotional materials that you supply and a hyperlink to your website or social media page. The event will also feature dinner options thanks to **The Wheel Apizza Pub** and **Sweet Life**; gourmet pizza, salad, dessert and tasty beverages delivered directly to your front door (within reasonable distance). We are honored this year to present our special live music guest, **International Reggae Recording Artist & Legend Norma Fraser** accompanied by **Bandulus**. The night will end with our famous live auction featuring auctioneer extraordinaire, Tim Reams! This is not your ordinary and boring Zoom meeting.... we are gonna have a wildly good time creating an unforgettable night!

#### With your support, we can continue fighting Major Ongoing Battles:

- 1. Challenge destructive post-fire "salvage" logging practices and protect natural post-fire forest regeneration.
- 2. Oppose thousands of acres of reckless timber sales through close monitoring and litigation.
- 3. Secure lasting protections for wild salmon from harmful suction-dredge mining.
- 4. Permanently close commercial and recreational beaver trapping and hunting on our federally managed public lands. Beavers are instrumental in creating and maintaining habitat that improves water quality, decreasing the impacts of floods, and restoring natural water flows.
- 5. Continue working to find a creative management solution for the iconic 93,000-acre Elliott State Forest in the Oregon Coast Range which has been clear-cut for nearly 50 years.
- 6. Reinforce protections for gray wolves; stop continued state sponsored wolf kills in OR and WA.



Thanks to generous community support, every dollar we raise at this event directly contributes to Cascadia Wildlands' work to protect and restore our incredible Cascadia bioregion. In 2019, revenue from our Wonderland Auction made up more than 1/4 of our annual operating budget. Auction item donors, in-kind sponsors and cash sponsors benefit from publicity during the online event, on our website, in our spring issue newsletter, and cause-affiliation benefits. We are a 501(c)3 non-profit organization, and as such, most donations are tax-deductible. We understand that this has been a rough year for all of us and any donation is greatly appreciated.
